Public Information Open House

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority (GRTA) will hold a public information open house to present the current status of the alternatives under consideration for the Northwest Corridor (I-75/I-575) project in Fulton, Cobb, and Cherokee Counties.

The Northwest Corridor Project proposes:

- construction of High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes and Truck Only Lanes (TOL) along I-75 between Akers Mill Rd. and Hickory Grove Rd.
- construction of HOV lanes on I-575 from the I-75/I-575 Interchange to Sixes Road in Cherokee County.
- implementation of a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system along the I-75 corridor from Cobb County to Downtown Atlanta.
- location of BRT stations along I-75 between the Cumberland and Town Center areas.

There will be no formal presentation, but project representatives will address individual comments and concerns

Study area maps and displays will be available.

A continuous video presentation on the project will be shown.

A court reporter will record individual comments during the open house.
